## License Definitions

**Transient** public lodging establishment means the intention is that guest occupancy will be temporary (includes the following license types: Transient Apartment (2003), Motels (2002), Hotels (2001), and Vacation Rental (2006 or 2007), Bed and Breakfast (2005).

**Non-Transient** lodging establishment means the intention is that the dwelling unit occupied will be the sole residence of the guest, and is not temporary (includes the following license type: Apartment (2003).

## **Important Reminders:**

- ✓ The license application AND fees must be processed prior to scheduling a licensing inspection
- ✓ An on-site inspection is required prior to issuing the license
- ✓ For new construction, a Certificate of Occupancy or sign-off from the local municipality is required
