

HELP ON USING THE H&R FEE CALCULATORS

To calculate your license fee, complete the numbered areas in **yellow**.

Step 1. Choose the county your business is in from the list. This determines the licensing district and expiry, which in turn affects 1/2 year prorating.

! H&R district office (per step 1)

! Renewal dates (per step 1)

! Definitions of license types (per step 2)

Step 2. Choose the license type that best describes your business. License fees are based in part on type. As you choose, the definition at the bottom will change to assist you in making the right choice.

Step 3. Enter the number of seats, carts or units. Must have this for lodging, permanent seating or theme park food cart applications.

! Choose this button if you want to print the result

Step 4. Choose the appropriate button. This determines if the \$50 application fee is required.

Step 5. Enter your planned opening date. For new and change of ownership applications, this will affect the full or 1/2 year fee determination, especially when nearing a renewal cycle.

LICENSE TYPE DEFINITION (Scroll down for more information)
Rule 61C-1.002(5)(b), Florida Administrative Code: Seating - seating establishments are classified as those public food service establishments that provide and maintain accommodations for consumption of food on the premises of the establishment or under the control of the establishment. The operator of the establishment is responsible for providing the number of seats available to the public to the division prior to licensing. Any changes in the number of seats provided which may affect the license fee, the Florida Clean Indoor Air Act, fire safety, bathroom requirements or any other sanitation and safety requirements provided in law or rule, shall be reported immediately to the division by the operator.
