61C-5.0085	Remove specific education and experience and related requirements from the continuing education provider requirements; allow the division to audit registered providers and to review and audit approved courses; adopt the application form and documentation requirements; provide minimum requirements for distance learning courses; update course certificate requirements; and prohibit using the state seal, department logo, or representing division endorsement in advertisements. 61C-5.007	Specify the licensure and registration time frames for validity and expiration; adopt licensure and registration forms; specify the certificate of competency is a credential only; specify requirements for licensure, registration, and renewal; define “good standing” as the term relates to certified elevator inspectors; and delineate the general liability insurance requirements for certified elevator technicians, certified elevator inspectors, and registered elevator companies. Amend the section title to reflect fully the contents of the rule section.	January 3, 2012
61C-5.023	New rule about the process, fines and form for citations and stop work orders.	January 10, 2012
61C-5.008	Define what constitutes a major modification that would require an elevator to comply with the Phase II Firefighters’ Service requirements. Also amend the definitions to specify a course instructor teaches or leads a continuing education course; that current satisfactory inspections must be completed by certified elevator inspectors; state the type of renewal application that requires a current satisfactory inspection; and update a statute citation to conform to changes made by Chapter 2010-110, Laws of Florida. 61C-5.018	New rule on the elevator variance request process that follows the variance petition requirements in Section 120.542, Florida Statutes. Provides the mailing address to submit the petition, adopts an optional variance petition form, and specifies responsibilities.	January 18, 2012
61C-5.001	Adopts American Society of Mechanical Engineers elevator safety codes; and removes adoption of the Florida Building Code, the inspection guide, fire safety rules, exclusions, and the conflict statement.	March 15, 2012
