61C-3.001	Clarify the requirements for the sanitation notice to guests; remove Food Code compliance for new or extensively remodeled public lodging establishments; and specify that establishments licensed as nontransient apartments are not subject to certain kitchen requirements.	August 10, 2011
61C-4.023	Allow division-approved public food service employee training programs to be provided through a variety of instructional formats, including interactive distance learning.	August 10, 2011
61C-1.0021	Repealed the rule.	December 8, 2011
61C-8.004	Eliminate the grant maximum amount currently adopted in the rule, adopt current forms, remove references to the program administrator, and update the review process to match current practice. Also, reduce conflict of interest in the grant review process, remove an unnecessary contract cancellation and termination clause, and remove a restriction on increasing the grant amount with an amended contract.	December 29, 2011
61C-1.008	Remove language that duplicates statutory requirements, replace the license classification of “resort condominiums” and “resort dwellings” with “vacation rentals”, identify vacation rentals as condominiums and dwellings for licensing purposes, and reduce the variance request fee to \$0.	January 18, 2012
61C-1.004	Remove rules relating to fire safety and update bathroom requirements to conform to the changes made by Chapter <a href="#">2008-055</a> , Laws of Florida; and remove other agency rules incorporated by reference to defer approval and enforcement of water supply, bottled and packaged potable water, sewage disposal, and garbage and rubbish removal to the agencies with jurisdiction. Replace reference to “resort condominiums” and “resort dwellings” with the term “vacation rental” to conform to the changes made by Chapter <a href="#">2011-119</a> , Laws of Florida.
