1. Discuss and draft rules language

- a) 61H1-27.001 College Or University Requirements
- b) 61H1-27.002 Concentrations in Accounting and Business

The Committee discussed the need to ease education requirements and reduce the 36 and 39 hour requirement for licensure. With regards to the accounting requirement, Mr. Dennis and Mr. Vogel agreed upon 30 required hours with Dr. Fennema suggesting 33 required hours.

Discussion regarding eliminating accounting course specificity resulted in members voted 2-1 to keep current requirement which requires coverage of auditing, cost, financial, taxation, and accounting information systems. Members also voted, 2-1, to require business law course include coverage of contracts, torts, and the uniform commercial code.

Accreditation and a pathway for foreign students were also discussed (please see attached charts).

Members discussed the social security number requirement and decided to table discussion, as this requirement is found in Chapter 455, Florida Statutes, and affects all professions under the DBPR umbrella.
