Appointed by Governor Ron DeSantis to serve as Secretary of the Florida Department of Business and Professional Regulation (DBPR) beginning January 1, 2022, Melanie S. Griffin, Esq. leads Florida's regulation of more than 1.4 million licensees across more than 30 fields of industry.

Directors Message

Not every state has the same educational requirements to sit for the CPA exam or to become a licensed CPA. Florida's educational requirements sometimes prove challenging for CPAs who are licensed in other states and wish to apply for licensure by endorsement here in Florida. A licensed CPA, with a minimum of five years of work

experience since becoming licensed, catches a break in F.S. 473.308 (8), which states "the board shall waive the requirements of subsection (3) which are in excess of a baccalaureate degree." (emphasis added). When a licensed CPA from another state, with a minimum of five years work experience since he or she was licensed, applies for licensure, the board staff focuses on proof of a baccalaureate degree from an accredited college or university. Board staff is not looking for additional specific course work that is required of an applicant with less work experience.

During my short tenure as director, I have seen many endorsement applicants after the applicant satisfies the five-year work experience requirement.

My concern is with licensed CPAs who move here, become Florida residents and who are employed by a Florida CPA firm with an office here in Florida. While they are working here, waiting on the five-year mark to apply for a license, they must not hold themselves out simply as a Jane Doe, CPA. The board feels strongly that using that simple designation coupled with the office location, implies incorrectly that they are a licensed Florida CPA.

Pursuant to Rule 61H1-20.002 F.A.C. (5) An out-of-state certified public accountant who is a resident of Florida may not practice as a certified public accountant in Florida through the use of temporary licenses or the practice privileges granted to Section 473.3141, F.S., nor may he assume or use the titles or designations "certified public accountant," or "public accountant" or the abbreviation "CPA," or any other title, designation, words, letters, abbreviations, sign, card, or device tending to indicate that he holds an active license under Chapter 473, F.S., nor shall such person attest as an expert in accountancy to the reliability or fairness of presentation of financial information or utilize any form of disclaimer of opinion which is intended or conventionally understood to convey an assurance of reliability as to matters not specifically disclaimed unless such person holds an active license under Chapter 473, F.S. This rule shall not prohibit the performance by such persons of other services involving the use of accounting skills, including the preparation of tax returns and the preparation of financial statements without expression of opinion thereon.

So, as a person waits to apply for a Florida license, they should not practice public accounting by providing or offering to provide audit or attestation services and should not hold oneself out in a fashion implying they are a Florida CPA. The only way to both reside in Florida and hold oneself out to the public to practice as a CPA is to have a Florida license. Those who move to Florida but are not licensed in Florida, must not hold out to the public. To do so, invites discipline for unlicensed practice. Anyone who is both a resident and practicing in Florida is in violation of Florida laws and rules, and they should self-report the violation as part of their application for a Florida license.

The Chair's Corner

Do you know a Florida resident licensed as a CPA in another jurisdiction (but not in Florida)? If you do, please call their attention to this message.

Recently, when introduced to another guest at a social gathering, I learned that the individual was a CPA. Board staff has labored without any funding or staff supplement to put together this

informative publication, and I was fishing for a compliment when asking the guest about this newsletter. The response floored me. The "CPA" indicated they did not hold a Florida license.

This individual had just held themselves out as a CPA to a member of the state licensing board, yet blissfully indicated that they did not have a license in Florida. Further, they told me they were not required to have a Florida license but could still tell everyone and anyone that they are a CPA. This was news to me. Sadly, I was quickly spirited away from this individual by my better half and did not have the opportunity to gather identifying information.

While Florida has full mobility for CPAs resident and fully licensed in another jurisdiction to practice in Florida (F.S. §473.3141), once a CPA becomes a Florida resident then they must license in Florida if they wish to use the CPA designation.

Rule 61H1-29.002 (5) provides (in pertinent part) "An out-of-state certified public accountant who is a resident of Florida may not practice as a certified public accountant in Florida through the use of temporary licenses or the practice privileges granted to Section 473.3141, F.S., nor may he assume or use the titles or designations "certified public accountant," or "public accountant" or the abbreviation "CPA," or any other title, designation, words, letters, abbreviations, sign, card, or device tending to indicate that he holds an active license under Chapter 473, F.S."

So, the "CPA" in this story was partly correct. They could become a Florida resident and continue to be a licensed CPA in another jurisdiction. They were also partly wrong; they cannot use the title CPA suggesting that they are licensed to practice in Florida. Since few who hold the CPA designation want to keep quiet about their license, an individual using a business card, web listing on a portal such as Linkedin or the like could indicate that they are not licensed in Florida or omit the CPA credential.

A Florida resident holding a CPA in another jurisdiction could, if not offering services to the public, identify themselves (for example) as Jane Doe, CPA (Texas) which would indicate that the individual was not licensed in Florida.

A Florida resident indicating that they are a CPA when they are not is a potential unlicensed activity issue. In accordance with the Department of Business and Professional Regulation's mission to license efficiently and regulate fairly, it is imperative for individuals claiming to have a Florida CPA license to <u>actually have</u> the license.
