Diagram and description of the outdoor area to be designated as available to patrons' dogs, including dimensions of the designated area; a depiction of the number and placement of tables, chairs, and restaurant equipment, if any; the entry ways and exits to the designated outdoor area; the boundaries of the designated area and of other areas of outdoor dining not available for patrons' dogs; any fences or other barriers; surrounding property lines and public rights-of-way, including sidewalks and common pathways. The diagram or plan shall be accurate and to scale but need not be prepared by a licensed design professional. CAUTION: At no time shall dogs be permitted to travel through indoor or nondesignated outdoor portions of the public food service establishment.	
2.	Description of the days of the week and hours of operation that patrons' dogs will be permitted in the designated outdoor area.	
3.	Attach a copy of the establishment's policy for all employees that states:	
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Employees shall wash their hands promptly after touching, petting or otherwise handling dogs. Employees shall be prohibited from touching, petting, or otherwise handling dogs while serving food or beverages, handling tableware or 	

	before entering other parts of the public food service establishment.	
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> All table and chair surfaces shall be cleaned and sanitized with an approved product between seating of patrons. Spilled food and drink shall be removed from the floor or ground between seating of patrons. 	
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Accidents involving dog waste shall be cleaned immediately and the area sanitized with an approved product. 	
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Description and location of dog waste kit. 	
4.	Method and description of notification to employees and patrons of the public food service establishment for the following:	
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Patrons shall be advised that they should wash their hands prior to eating. Waterless hand sanitizer shall be provided at all tables in the designated outdoor area. 	
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Dogs shall not come into contact with serving dishes, utensils, tableware, linens, paper products, or any other items involved in food service operations. 	
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Patrons shall keep their dogs on a leash at all times and shall keep their dogs under reasonable control. 	
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Dogs shall not be allowed on chairs, tables, or other furnishings. 	
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Dogs shall not be permitted to travel through indoor and non-designated outdoor portions of the public food service establishment. 	
5.	Description and location of sign(s) reminding employees of the applicable rules.	
6.	Description and location of sign(s) reminding patrons of the applicable rules.	
7.	Description and location of public notification that the designated outdoor area is available for the use of patrons and patrons' dogs.
