DID YOU KNOW? Election Envelope

- That the association must have, at the election meeting, additional blank ballots for distribution to eligible voters who have not cast their votes?
- That the association may create an impartial committee to verify the ballot outer envelope information in advance of the meeting as long as the meeting is noticed in the same manner as a board meeting and held on the date of the election?
- That the impartial committee cannot be composed of any current board members, officers or their spouses or any candidates running for the board?
- That a unit owner's omission of their unit number(s) on the outer envelope will not cause the ballot to be disregarded?
- That a unit owner's failure to print their name on the outer envelope, so long as there is a signature on the outer envelope, will not cause the ballot to be disregarded?
