

THE PRELIMINARY TEXT OF THE PROPOSED RULE DEVELOPMENT:

61D-14.030 Video Monitors/Touchscreens.

(1) Games that have video monitors shall meet the following requirements:

(a)~~(4)~~ The slot machine licensee shall maintain any touch screen monitors to ensure the accuracy of the calibration of the machine;

(b)~~(2)~~ A touch screen shall be capable of being re-calibrated by the slot machine licensee's staff without access to the slot machine cabinet other than opening the main door;

(c)~~(3)~~ There shall be no hidden or undocumented buttons or touch points anywhere on a touch screen; and

(d)~~(4)~~ The slot machine shall be capable of displaying all possible outcomes of play of the machine during testing.

(2) The slot machine licensee shall submit a quarterly written testing and certification report to the division. An authorized representative of the facility management shall sign each report attesting to the following:

(a) The licensee has completed testing of 10% of all slot machine licensee facility monitors/touchscreens;

(b) The tested monitors/touchscreens were randomly selected for the test; and

(c) The facility certifies that the monitor/touchscreens in the random test reported have not been tested in the prior quarter.

(3) The quarterly written testing and certification report shall also include the following for each slot machine tested:

(a) The slot machine location/asset number;

(b) The game theme or themes resident on the slot machine;

(c) The name and license number of the slot machine licensee employee who performed the test;

(d) The results of each test stating whether the monitor/touchscreen passed or failed; and

(e) The disposition of any monitors/touchscreens that failed the random test.
