

THE PRELIMINARY TEXT OF THE PROPOSED RULE DEVELOPMENT IS:

(Substantial rewording of Rule 61D-14.050, F.A.C., follows. See Florida Administrative Code for present text.)

61D-14.050 Floor Plan.

(1) No slot machine licensee shall operate any slot machine unless:

(a) The licensee has submitted a floor plan of the slot machine gaming area to the division; and

(b) The division and FDLE have approved the floor plan pursuant to the requirements of this section;

and

(c) The licensee has received and implemented the floor plan the division and FDLE approved.

(2) The floor plan shall be based on a scale of one quarter inch equals one foot and demonstrates the placement or location of the following:

(a) Each slot machine with its corresponding location number;

(b) Each security camera or any other surveillance equipment;

(c) Each count room and cage;

(d) The designated slot machine gaming area in the licensee facility;

(e) The security surveillance system monitoring room;

(f) The office space provided for use by the division and FDLE as required by Rule 61D-14.018,

F.A.C.;

(g) The armored car bay which is capable of accommodating the loading and unloading of an armored car while the armored care is enclosed within the armored car bay. Multiple armored car bays may be designated in the proposed plan; and

(h) All man traps contained within the slot machine licensee's facility used to control access to restricted areas of the facility.

(3) The designated slot machine gaming area shall:

(a) Be separated from all other facility public space by a physical barrier;

(b) Have controlled entry and exit points which shall:

1. Be under constant camera surveillance; and

2. Have the required personnel in position to control entry and exit from the slot machine gaming area.

(c) Have security personnel who shall:

1. Be prominently stationed at each entry and exit point during all periods the gaming floor is open to patrons;

2. Check the identification of all patrons seeking access to the slot machine gaming area according to the facility internal control procedures;

3. Permit only those persons authorized pursuant to Chapter 551, F.S. and Chapter 61D-14, F.A.C. to enter the slot machine gaming area.

(d) Be controlled to ensure no persons under twenty-one (21) years of age are allowed access to the designated slot machine gaming area.

(4) The floor plan shall provide for clear lines of sight for the security surveillance system. The slot machine licensee's security surveillance system shall be positioned to monitor all areas in any part of the slot machine licensee's facility where slot machines are played or where money is collected, distributed, or counted. All security surveillance shall be conducted with the clarity required in Rule 61D-14.054, F.A.C.

(5) A slot machine licensee shall submit proposed changes to its approved floor plan to the division for review.

(a) The licensee shall use Form DBPR PMW- 3480, Machine Conversion/Relocation Worksheet, adopted and incorporated by Rule 61D-15.001, F.A.C. shall be used to document the request for relocation or conversion of slot machines listed on the facility floor plan.

(b) The licensee shall use Form DBPR PMW- 3481, Machine Adjustment Verification Sheet, adopted and incorporated by Rule 61D-15.001, F.A.C. to document the actual relocation or conversion of slot machines listed on the facility floor plan.

(6) The division shall review the proposed changes with FDLE for compliance with the security standards of Chapter 551, F.S. and those set forth in these rules.

(a) No physical changes shall be made to the gaming floor without the approval of the division and FDLE.

(b) The division shall notify the slot machine licensee within 30 days of its approval the proposed floor plan, or of changes required to obtain approval.

(c) If the floor plan is for a pre-approved slot machine tournament floor plan, the slot machine licensee can change the floor plan upon seven days notice to the division and FDLE.

(7) A copy of the floor plan shall be maintained in the surveillance control room and the slot department office. A copy shall be provided to the division and FDLE for use in the secure monitoring room.
