

THE PRELIMINARY TEXT OF THE PROPOSED RULE DEVELOPMENT IS:

(Substantial rewording of Rule 61D-14.055, F.A.C., follows. See Florida Administrative Code for present text.)

61D-14.055 Storage and Retrieval of Surveillance Recordings.

(1) All surveillance recordings shall be:

(a) In digital format;

(b) Retained for at least 30 days pursuant to Rule 61D-14.080(3)(b), F.A.C. unless:

1. The slot machine licensee determines for its own purposes a surveillance recording is required for a specific purpose; or

2. The division or FDLE notifies the slot machine licensee that a surveillance recording is required to support an investigation or that a slot machine licensee's investigation is being taken over; and

3. The slot machine licensee is required to retain the surveillance recording, in which case the surveillance recording shall be retained until:

a. The slot machine licensee's self imposed investigation has been completed; or

b. The division or FDLE has provided written authorization to dispose of the surveillance record in those cases where an investigation that was either initiated or taken over by the division or FDLE has been concluded;

(c) Listed on a record by surveillance personnel with the date, time, and identification of the person monitoring or changing the recording medium in a recorder; and

(d) Released to the division or FDLE upon demand.

(2) Any surveillance recording of illegal or suspected illegal activity or illegal or suspected illegal jackpot payment procedures, upon completion of the monitoring, shall be:

(a) Saved and stored separately from all other surveillance records;

(b) Labeled with the applicable date and time of the recorded incident and the identity of the responsible surveillance personnel;

(c) Placed in a separate, secure area;

(d) Reported in writing to the division and FDLE. The written notification shall include information regarding the incident and the availability of the surveillance records.

(e) Retained in permanent storage and not destroyed without the written authorization of the division and FDLE.

(3) All surveillance recordings relating to the following shall be retained in a secure area pursuant to the requirements of this rule and shall be listed on a record maintained by surveillance personnel:

(a) All count room areas;

(b) The vault area;

(c) All credit and fill slip confirmation recordings; and

(d) Any areas with cashiers or where the patrons cash tickets, vouchers or receive cash to include both the cash cage and ATM equipment located on the licensee's facility.
