

Mixed Games

Some of the most common types of mixed poker games are H.O.R.S.E. or H.E.R.O.S. These mixed games consist of a mixture of poker games that are played in rotation. It gives the players a chance to play different types of poker without switching tables and searching for new games.

For example, H.O.R.S.E. alternates Hold'Em, Omaha High, Razz (Seven Card Stud), and Omaha Eight or Better (Omaha High/Low). Some popular variations are listed below.

- H.O. – Fixed Limit Hold'Em and Omaha.
- H.A. – Pot Limit Hold'Em and Omaha-This game is the same as H.O. except it is pot limit instead of fixed limit.
- H.O.E. – Fixed Limit Hold'Em, Omaha and Seven Card Stud High/Low -This game is the same as H.O. except Seven Card Stud High/Low is added to the mix.
- O.A. – Pot Limit Omaha and Omaha High/Low. This game switches between pot limit Omaha and pot limit Omaha High/Low.
- O.E. – Fixed Limit Omaha High/Low and Seven Card Stud High/Low.
- H.E.R.O.S. - H.E.R.O.S. is nearly identical to H.O.R.S.E. except for the order in which the games are played. The lineup includes the following games:
H – Texas Hold'Em
E – Seven Card Stud Eight or Better
R – Razz
O – Omaha High/Low
S – Seven Card Stud
- Seven Card Mutual - Mixture of Seven Card Stud and Texas Hold'Em.
