Major Issues/Actions

- Jon Glogau the lead attorney representing the board in the Institute for Justice lawsuit in the case of Locke v. Shore, provided an update on the status of the lawsuit. Mr. Glogau indicated three amicus briefs were filed, but each did not contain any significant information that was presented to the court. Mr. Glogau informed the board that oral arguments are scheduled for early September.
- Rick Logan provided an update of the activities of the Florida American Institute of Architects (FAIA). The institute is still working with the building officials in Florida to determine the division of duties between architects and engineers.
- Based on the comments from Mr. Logan, the board discussed convening a joint meeting with the Board of Engineers and the Board of Landscape Architecture to discuss and understand what duties the respective professions can and cannot do.
- The board received the financial report for the period ending March 31, 2010.

The operating account has a balance of \$884,750, and the unlicensed activity account has a balance of 356,953.

- Mr. Minacci provided his disciplinary report to the board.
- Ms. Solera and Ms. Dolan served their last meeting with the board because of term limits, and replacements have been named to succeed them at the next board meeting. Both departing members were presented with a plaque during the meeting for their service to the state and the board.
