### **Major Issues/Actions**

Jon Glogau the lead attorney representing the board in the Institute for Justice lawsuit in the case of Locke v. Shore, provided an update on the status of the lawsuit. Mr. Glogau indicated the plaintiffs have filed their amicus brief for review by the District Court of Appeals. Mr. Glogau advised the board he would provide a response within two weeks.

Rick Logan, President of Florida American Institute of Architect addressed the board regarding the responsibilities of architects and engineers. Mr. Logan indicated that some building departments are trying to determine which duties are specifically related to the architect and engineer professions. The board informed Mr. Logan they will assist where they can in addressing the matter.

The board addressed an inquiry requesting information on electronically sealing

documents. Ms. Clark informed the board that Rule 61G1-16.005, Florida Administrative Code, currently provides the procedures for electronically sealing documents.

The board received the financial report for the period ending December 31, 2009. The operating account has a balance of \$1,084,466 and the unlicensed activity account has a balance of \$351,190.

Mr. Minacci provided his disciplinary report to the board.
