Meryl Towarnicki – State Endorsement

Ms. Towarnicki was present. Ms. Towarnicki applied for licensure under Section 481.213(3)(b), Florida Statutes. Ms. Towarnicki was licensed in Pennsylvania in 2011, took and passed the Architecture Registration Examination, completed NCARB IDP, and graduated from Spring

Garden College with a five year professional degree in architecture. In 2011, Florida Statutes allowed for review and approval of non-NAAB accredited schools of architecture as outlined in Rule 61G1-13.003, Florida Administrative Code.
