- In accordance with Chapter 469.002(3), Florida Statutes, licensure as an asbestos contractor or consultant is not required for the moving, removal, or disposal of asbestos-containing resilient floor covering or its adhesive, provided the following conditions are met:
- a) The resilient floor covering is a Category I nonfriable material as defined in NESHAP and remains a Category I nonfriable material during removal activity.
 - b) All such activities are performed according to the recommended work practices as set forth by OSHA in 29 CFR 1926.1101.
 - c) The removal is not subject to asbestos licensing or accreditation requirements pursuant to federal asbestos NESHAP regulations as promulgated by the United States Environmental Protection Agency.
 - d) Written notice of the time, place and company performing such removal is provided to this department at least three days prior to such removal. The contractor removing such flooring is responsible for maintaining proof that all the conditions required under this paragraph are met.
