Major Issues/Actions

- The board reviewed one application for licensure that had criminal history on the application and after deliberation of the case, the applicant was approved.
- Mr. Dietrich discussed Senate Bill 1486 which details requirements for applicants of auctioneer licenses to obtain fingerprints to detect criminal backgrounds before being approved for licensure. The board was informed the bill did not pass at the current legislative session. The board members did request that the bill be submitted as part of a legislative package for next year's session. The Executive Director informed the board members it may be more feasible to obtain a sponsor to file the bill as the department has not decided if a legislative package will be submitted.
- Ms. Leigh provided a case-load report to the board members to keep them apprised of the number of cases being worked in the department relative to auctioneers. Currently there are 30 cases in legal being reviewed and processed by the prosecuting attorney.
- No financial report was provided to the board as the official reports were not released in time for the meeting. The board will be apprised of the financial standing at the next board meeting scheduled in September.
- The board was provided a copy of proposed meeting dates for the upcoming fiscal year. The proposed dates are September 20, 2006; December 13, 2006; March 14, 2007; and June 14, 2007. The September meeting has tentatively been set for Ft. Lauderdale.
