Motion: Mr. Accardo moved to approve the application list as presented. Second: Mr. Shearer seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

PROSECUTING ATTORNEY REPORT

CASE LOAD STATUS

Ms. Leigh's report dated May 22, 2009 reflected seven cases in legal, one case set for probable cause, zero cases set for expert review, three cases set for administrative complaint, one case set for default, one case set for settlement negotiations and one case set for board presentation. There were a total of fourteen cases in legal.

Ms. Leigh reported an updated list dated June 9, 2008 and it reflected six cases in legal, zero cases set for expert review, four cases set for administrative complaint, one case set for settlement negotiations, one awaiting final order and one case set for board presentation. There were a total of thirteen cases in legal.

Ms. Leigh indicated to the board that she's receiving less cases due to the department reaching out to the communities and doing more outreach classes thought out the state.

#2007-048433, All Out Auctions and Delivery, Inc.

Ms. Leigh presented case #2007-048433, AB2463. The respondent was not present and was not sworn in via the court reporter. The department filed an administrative complaint against respondent on May 16, 2008. The administrative complaint charged the respondent with violating Rule 61G2-7.030(1)(L), Florida Administrative Code for violating any lawfully issued order of the Board or Department previously entered in a disciplinary hearing, or failure to comply with a lawfully issued subpoena of the Department. The respondent has failed to file an election of rights form or otherwise disputing issues and material facts of the administrative complaint pursuant to Rule 28-106.111, F.A.C. By failing to request a hearing within 21 days of receipt of agency pleading, the respondent has waived his right to request a hearing where there is a disputed issue of material facts.

Ms. Leigh stated that "the department believes that it is appropriate for the Chair to entertain a motion adopting the allegations and facts and conclusion of law contained in the administrative complaint of those of the board after which the department will request that the board impose penalties within their guidelines."

Motion: Mr. Accardo moved to approve the findings of facts and conclusions of

law.

Second: Mr. Shearer seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

Ms. Leigh stated that "the department's recommendation in this case is that the respondent pay a fine in the amount of \$1000, costs of \$94.98 and revoke his license."

Motion: Mr. Shearer made a motion for the board to accept the recommendation

of the department.

Second: Mr. Dietrich seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

The board voiced their concerns regarding unlicensed auctioneers continuing to operate on a revoked license. At the next meeting Mr. Spivey will be presenting to the board procedures that the electrical contractor board have in place to police their profession.

BOARD COUNSEL REPORT

Ms. Edward presented a copy of the reinstatement of a null and void application to the board for their approval.

Motion: Mr. Dietrich made a motion for Ms. Edwards to file the reinstatement of a

null and void application.

Second: Mr. Shearer seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

BOARD CHAIR REPORT

Mr. Moecker indicated that the fingerprint bill died and the board will continue to fight for the bill.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

(Operating, Recovery, Unlicensed)

Mr. Spivey reviewed the financial reports ending March 31, 2008. He indicated that the "operation account shows a balance of \$269,133. The operating account for the recovery fund shows a balance of \$797,385. In the unlicensed activity account shows a balance of \$37,023."

Ms. Ewell provided the board with a short course on submitting their travel vouchers.
