Vice-Chair Gathright stated that some were demanding that everyone accept plans electronically. He stated that it would cost \$1.2 million for his Department to accept the plans electronically as software and hardware would have to be modified.

Leadership Symposium

Chair McCormick stated that this was provided for information purposes and that he felt the information provided was very meaningful and a good networking opportunity.

Vice-Chair Gathright stated that he was impressed with the Call Center, and the flow of the applications through the system was very informative.
