

\* If a swimming pool permit is pulled by a general contractor, the general contractor must subcontract with a pool contractor for all non structural pool work per Section 489.113(3)(c), Florida Statutes. The pool contractor shall then subcontract with other contractors as required. Electrical or other subs should be designated by the pool contractor.

\*Swimming pool installations, whether the permit is issued to a swimming pool contractor or a general contractor, must have an associated electrical permit either as a separate permit or a sub-permit of the main pool permit. The electrical permit is required and must be issued to a qualified electrical contractor.
