1. General Requirements

- a. This form is required if you are changing the status of a qualifying agent from a primary to secondary qualifying agent, or a secondary to primary qualifying agent.
- b. **Note:** All qualified businesses **must** have at least one Primary Qualifying Agent.
- c. Definition of "Primary Qualifying Agent"
 - i. A contractor, qualifying a business entity, who has final approval authority for all construction work performed by the business entity and final approval authority on all business matters, including contracts, specifications, checks, drafts, or payments regardless of the form of payment, made by the business entity, except where a Financially Responsible Officer is approved.
 - ii. **Note:** If multiple Primary Qualifying Agents are designated without appointing a Financially Responsible Officer, **ALL** Primary Qualifying Agents will be jointly and severally liable for all construction and business matters of the business entity.
- d. Definition of "Secondary Qualifying Agent"
 - i. A contractor, qualifying a business entity, who has authority to supervise all construction work performed by the business entity.

2. Application Instructions (by section)

- a. **Section I- Transaction Type**
 - i. Select the transaction you wish to conduct. Select only one transaction.
- b. **Section II- Business Information**
 - i. Complete this section entirely.
 - ii. Provide the name of the business to be qualified as it is registered with the Florida Division of Corporations.
 - iii. The "Doing Business As" (D/B/A) name must be provided as it is registered with the Florida Division of Corporations, if the business uses a fictitious name to conduct business.
 - iv. Applicants must provide the Federal Employer Identification Number (FEID) for the business to be qualified.
 - v. Select the box that indicates the type of business ownership for the business to be qualified.
 - vi. Applicants must provide the business mailing address of the business to be qualified.
 - vii. Business contact information is often used to quickly resolve questions with applications by telephone call or email. Please provide the name of an authorized representative of the business other than the primary qualifier. This could be an officer, a partner, etc. If the business is a Sole Proprietorship, you may leave the contact information field blank.
 - (1) If contact information is not provided, questions regarding applications will be mailed to the applicant's mailing address and may take longer to resolve.
 - viii. Provide the business location address of the business to be qualified. If this address is the same as the mailing address you may leave this information blank.
- c. **Section III- Change from Primary to Secondary Qualifying Agent**
(Complete this section only if you are changing the status of a Primary Qualifying Agent to a Secondary Qualifying Agent.)
 - i. Complete this section entirely
 - ii. In the "New Primary Qualifier" section, provide the name and license number of the person who is designated as the replacement Primary Qualifying Agent. This may be an existing Primary Qualifying Agent if the business entity has multiple Primary Qualifying Agents, or this may be a Secondary Qualifying Agent who will now be the Primary Qualifying Agent.
 - iii. **Note:** If a Primary Qualifying Agent is not designated, **ALL** Secondary Qualifying Agents will become Primary Qualifying Agents.
 - iv. **Note:** All primary qualifiers must have final approval authority on all business matters, including contracts, specifications, checks, drafts, or payments, regardless of the form of payment, made by the business entity.
 - (1) If the primary qualifier does not have final approval authority, the business entity must have a Financially Responsible Officer.

- (a) If the business entity has already appointed a Financially Responsible Officer, provide the name of that individual.
 - (b) If the business entity has not appointed a Financially Responsible Officer, you **must** appoint a Financially Responsible Officer by completing **Form # DBPR CILB 8**.
- v. In the “New Secondary Qualifier” section, provide the name and license number of the person who is changing status from a Primary Qualifying Agent to a Secondary Qualifying Agent.
- d. **Section IV- Change from Secondary to Primary Qualifying Agent**
(Complete this section only if you are changing the status of a Secondary Qualifying Agent to a Primary Qualifying Agent.)
 - i. Complete this section entirely.
 - ii. In the “New Primary Qualifier” section, provide the name and license number of the person who is changing status from a Secondary Qualifying Agent to a Primary Qualifying Agent.
 - iii. **Note:** All primary qualifiers must have final approval authority on all business matters, including contracts, specifications, checks, drafts, or payments, regardless of the form of payment, made by the business entity.
 - (1) If the primary qualifier does not have final approval authority, the business entity must have a Financially Responsible Officer.
 - (a) If the business entity has already appointed a Financially Responsible Officer, provide the name of that individual.
 - (b) If the business entity has not appointed a Financially Responsible Officer, you **must** appoint a Financially Responsible Officer by completing **Form # DBPR CILB 8**.

 - i. This form must be signed by an officer of the business entity and the qualifying agent(s) involved in the transaction.
