Mr. Biggins informed the Board of Mr. Evetts' resignation from the Board.

With nothing further to report the Board voted unanimously to approve this report.

CHAIRMAN'S REPORT- Aaron Boyette

Mr. Boyette had nothing to report.

PROSECUTING ATTORNEY'S REPORT- Ian Brown

Mr. Brown thanked the board, and updated the board on the number of cases for the previous month and where OGC stands currently with processing cases.

The Notice of Intent to Deny was filed in February of 2020. Mr. Pfneisel timely requested an informal hearing.

After discussion, the board voted to vacate the previous denial and to approve the application.
