Janny Alcantara / Puerto Rico

Ms. Robyn Barineau, Executive Director, noted that the licensure application was denied at the August 31, 2011, board meeting because she failed to demonstrate that she meets the requirements of Section 477.019, Florida Statutes, and Rules 61G5-18.007 and/or 61G5-18.001, Florida Administrative Code. Ms. Alcantara was not present for the meeting. After review, Vice Chair Ginny Fincel moved to uphold the denial based on insufficient and/or inconsistent documentation demonstrating she meets the requirements of Section 477.019, Florida Statutes, and Rules 61G5-18.007 and/or 61G5-18.001, Florida Administrative Code. Ms. Laurel Ritenbaugh seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.
