UNLICENSED ACTIVITY (ULA) REPORT – Thomas McHaffie & David Botknecht

Ms. Erin Reisinger, Unlicensed Activity Administrator gave a report to the members on the unlicensed activity enforcement efforts. Ms. Reisinger stated there were 307 sweeps, 356 outreaches and 18 stings (8 of these stings involved electrical).

Ms. Reisinger reported that 92 cases have been initiated using the Department's new mobile app for reporting unlicensed activity and shared the Division of Regulation's goals for improving unlicensed activity enforcement efforts in the future.

EXAMINATION REPORT – Thomas McHaffie

Mr. Alex Bosque from the Bureau of Education and Testing addressed the Board and responded to questions regarding updating the exam to more current versions of the National Electric Code and Fire Protection Code. Mr. Bosque informed the Board that the Bureau of Education and Testing will look at updating the reference to the 2014 National Electric Code and will update the Board in November 2015.
