The Court Reporter swore in, as a group, the applicants and those persons providing testimony on behalf of the applicant. During the review each applicant and their respective designees were interviewed in turn and answered general questions concerning the business entity they wished to qualify and direct questions concerning their understanding of their responsibilities and obligations as primary qualifying agent.

Mr. Echarri asked of the second business applicants collectively as a group:

“Do you understand that you will be legally responsible for every job undertaken by this business?”

“Do you understand that you will be financially responsible for every job undertaken by this business?”

“Do you understand that you are required to approve the work done on every job undertaken by this business?”

“Do you understand that your license is dependent upon how seriously you take these responsibilities?”

Each applicant answered affirmatively to each of the preceding questions.

PROBATION COMMITTEE REPORT

Mr. Echarri reported he reviewed the reports and all were in order.

MOTION: Mr. Tibbs made a motion to accept the probation reports of Kevin Brock, Daniel Koppele, Ramon Lorente, Michael Perry, Julio E. Rosello, Ram Schratte, Randy Sjaardema, Gerard Thelusca, David C. Tyre, Roger Wells and Thomas Franklin Zirkle.

Motion passed unanimously.

LEGISLATIVE REPORT

Ms. Christie reported there is bill which would open grandfathering July 1, 2019 until November 2020.

Ms. Christie also reported there is a bill containing Board and Department suggestions from the Deregation. Items from this Board are allowing 90 days to take the FASA/BASA course after hire date, reduction of continuing education hours from 14 hours to 7 hours and endorsement applicants licensed 10 years would not have to show required experience.

DISCUSSION OF DEREGATION PROPOSALS

Rule 61G6-5.003, F.A.C. – Requirements for Certification

The Board reviewed the proposed rule change which would do the following:

- Current NICET Level III certification in lieu of job list for Alarm Contractor I applicants.
- Personal Financial Statement no longer required.

After further discussion, the following language was approved:

61G6-5.003 Requirements for Certification.

(1) Any person desiring certification by examination or applying for certification by endorsement pursuant to Section 489.511(5)(a), F.S., must establish that he or she meets eligibility requirements according to one of the following criteria:

(a) Has, within the 6 years immediately preceding the filing of the application, at least 3 years' proven management experience in the trade or education equivalent thereto, or a combination thereof, but not more than one-half of such experience may be educational equivalent.

1. An applicant for certification who is a recipient of a degree in engineering or related field from an accredited four-year college or university may substitute his or her educational background for 1 year of experience in the trade as an electrical contractor or an alarm contractor, provided that the applicant causes the college or university he or she attended to forward a copy of his or her transcript to the Department.

2. The experience required must include:

a. For an electrical contractor, at least 40% of work that is 3-phase service;
b. For an alarm contractor I, at least 40% of work that is in commercial fire alarm systems;

c. For an alarm contractor II, at least 40% of work in alarm systems other than fire alarm systems.

(b) Has, within the 8 years immediately preceding the filing of the application, at least 4 years' experience as a foreman, supervisor, or contractor in the trade for which he or she is making application. The experience must include:

1. For an electrical contractor, at least 40% of work that is 3-phase service;
2. For an alarm contractor I, at least 40% of work that is in fire alarm systems;
3. For an alarm contractor II, at least 40% of work in alarm systems other than fire alarm systems.

(c) Has, within 12 years immediately preceding the filing of the application, at least 6 years of comprehensive training, technical education, or broad experience associated with an electrical or an alarm system installation or servicing endeavor. The experience required must include:

1. For an electrical contractor, at least 40% of work that is 3-phase service;
2. For an alarm contractor I, at least 40% of work that is in fire alarm systems;
3. Alarm contractor II, at least 40% of work in alarm systems other than fire alarm systems.

(d) Has been licensed for 3 years as an engineer within the preceding 12 years.

(2) Every applicant must submit:

~~(a) A comprehensive financial statement reflecting the financial condition of the individual applicant during the previous fiscal year; provided, however, that the statement must have been prepared within 12 months of the date of filing of the application. The financial statement shall include a balance sheet.~~

(b) A credit report on the applicant from any recognized credit bureau which includes but is not limited to liens, judgments, suits and bankruptcy obtained from the county, state and federal records. The credit report must be dated within 12 months of the date of filing the application. Reports which are limited to only information that has been obtained from the applicant or past and present employers are not acceptable.

(3) All applicants attempting to demonstrate qualification by experience pursuant to Section 489.511(1)(b)3.a., b., c., F.S., must forward the following to the Board:

(a) A complete list of contracts by the applicant underway at the time of filing, along with a representative list of electrical contracts or alarm contracts, as applicable, completed in the requisite number of years preceding the date of application pursuant to the applicable part of the statute noted above. The list shall include the description of each job, location, owner, architect or engineer, and general contractor. If the applicant has been employed by a Florida Certified Electrical, Alarm or Specialty contractor for the requisite number of years preceding the date of application, he/she may have that licensee verify that he/she meets the requirements pursuant to the applicable part of the statute noted above on a form prescribed by the Department in lieu of providing a list of contracts. If the applicant is applying for the Certified Alarm System Contractor I license and has a NICET Level III certification, he or she may provide proof of the current NICET Level III certification in lieu of providing a list of contracts.

(b) Statements prepared by some person or persons other than the applicant for licensure by examination or endorsement listing chronologically the active experience of the applicant in the trade. The statements shall include the name and address of employers, and dates of employment. Copies of W-2 forms must be submitted with the application.

(4) A credit report on the qualifying agent from any recognized credit bureau which includes but is not limited to liens, judgments, suits and bankruptcy obtained from county, state and federal records. The credit report must be dated within twelve (12) months of the date of filing the application. Reports which are limited to only information that has been obtained from the qualifying agent or past and present employers are not acceptable.

MOTION: Mr. Tibbs made a motion to approve the draft language and to open this rule for development.

SECOND: Mr. Botknecht.

Motion passed unanimously.

MOTION: Mr. Tibbs made a motion there was no adverse financial impact in excess of \$200,000 in one year or \$500,000 over five years and no Statement of Estimated Regulatory Costs was required.

SECOND: Mr. Botknecht.

Motion passed unanimously.

The Board stated that this rule would not be a minor violation pursuant to Section 120.695, F.S.

Rule 61G6- 6.005, F.A.C. – Examination Retake Requirements

The Board reviewed the proposed rule change which would do the following:

- It removes the 21 day waiting period between retakes.
- It removes the CE requirement after 3 fails.
- It eliminates the need for a new initial exam application after a 3rd fail, applicants can just submit a retake application no matter how many times they fail.

After further discussion, the following language was approved:

61G6-6.005 Reexamination.

(1) An applicant who fails the Technical/Safety certification examination shall be entitled to take the next examination upon payment of the reexamination fee and compliance with subsection (2) of this rule, if applicable. The Business Computer-Based Test may be taken up to three (3) times after the candidate is initially approved to sit for the examination. The Technical/Safety examination portion may be taken up to three (3) times after the candidate is initially approved to sit for the examination. A retake exam application must be submitted to the Department for each attempt of the Technical/Safety portion of the examination. However, a retake exam application shall not be required to be submitted for each retake of the Computer-Based Test, and there shall be a 21-day waiting period between retakes of the Business Computer-Based Test.

~~(2) Prior to reexamination, an applicant who has taken and failed the certification examination portions 3 or more times, must complete a minimum of 7 hours of continuing education courses in area(s), technical, general business or safety, where a passing grade of 75% was not achieved on the last exam portions. Only courses taken in an area(s) in which a passing grade was not received will be counted toward meeting this requirement. If more than one area was not passed, the applicant must take 7 hours of~~

~~courses in each area where a passing grade was not achieved. Courses taken pursuant to this provision may not be used to satisfy any other educational requirement.~~

MOTION: Mr. Tibbs made a motion to approve the draft language and to open this rule for development.

SECOND: Mr. Botknecht.

Rule 61G6-9.005(3), F.A.C. – Registration of Course Providers

The Board reviewed the proposed rule change which would do the following:

- Change to CE Providers Registration, give them a 4 year renewal instead of the current 2 year.

After further discussion, the following language was approved:

61G6-9.005 Registration of Course Providers.

(1)(a) Each course provider must register with the Board prior to submitting any continuing education courses to be conducted by a course provider to the Board for approval.

(b) A university or college which is regionally accredited by an accrediting agency recognized by the United States Department of Education (USDOE); and which university or college offers courses in the contracting areas specified in part II, chapter 489, F.S., and pursuant to rule chapter 61G6-9, F.A.C., will be approved as a course provider upon submitting an application to the Board.

(2) The application for registration must be submitted on the ECLB Continuing Education Provider Approval Application, form number, BPR/ECLB/CONT.ED.PROV.APP/REV/4/2001, with instructions, hereby incorporated by reference, copies of which are provided by the Board upon request and must include the name, address, phone number and facsimile number of the course provider. The registration must also include the name and address of each person or entity who has an ownership interest in the course sponsor or who is entitled to receive any portion of the revenues from the course provider. A course provider making an application to offer interactive distance education must submit evidence of the following:

(a) That the course contains a high level of interactivity which promotes student involvement, and demonstrates that the program measures learning and assesses mastery of content at regular intervals.

(b) That the course provider will be able to monitor student enrollment, participation,

and course completion.

(c) That the course provider can demonstrate that stated course hours are consistent with the actual hours it takes to complete the course.

(d) That the course provider has qualified instructor(s) available to answer questions and provide the students with the necessary assistance during the duration of the course.

(e) That the student shall be required to complete and submit a statement at the end of the course that he/she has personally completed each module of instruction.

(3) The course provider registration is valid for four (4) years and expires on May 31st of every other odd numbered year. ~~is valid until May 31st of odd numbered years from the date of issue.~~
