### **EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT – Daniel Biggins**

Mr. Biggins provided the Board with draft legislative language for criminal background checks as they requested.

489.515(6) All initial applicants, shall provide fingerprints for criminal background checks in conjunction with the application. The applicant must submit an electronic set of fingerprints through a Florida Department of Law Enforcement approved vendor for a background check to be conducted by the Division of Criminal Justice Information Systems within the Florida Department of Law Enforcement and the Federal Bureau of Investigation to determine if the applicant has a criminal history record. The information obtained by the processing of the fingerprint record by the Florida Department of Law Enforcement and the Federal Bureau of Investigation shall be sent to the Department for the purpose of determining if the applicant is statutorily qualified for licensure. Applicants who reside outside the state of Florida may submit a fingerprint card containing the fingerprints of the applicant to a vendor approved by the Department. The cost of processing shall be borne by the applicant. The fees are to be collected by the authorized agencies or vendors who are responsible for paying the processing costs to the Department of Law Enforcement.
