UNLICENSED ACTIVITY (ULA) REPORT – Thomas McHaffie & David Botknecht

Ms. Larissa Vaughn, Investigative Supervisor with the Orlando Field Office gave a report to the members on unlicensed activity enforcement efforts in her region and played the newest public service announcement for the members.

The Board discussed several issues related to unlicensed activity enforcement including:

- A legislative proposal for discipline against Community Association Managers or Real Estate Agents who hire unlicensed electrical or alarm contractors.
- Having a representative from the local DBPR field offices attend Board meetings to update the Board on local efforts.
- Requested information regarding locations of ULA billboards and stations that are airing the public service announcements.
- Suggested sending out letters to individuals advertising themselves as "Handymen" warning them of unlicensed activity violations and possible consequences
- Requested to see copies of press releases related to unlicensed activity enforcement as part of the agenda
