Major Issues/Actions

- The board extended an invitation to Secretary Marstiller to attend the November board meeting scheduled in Tallahassee for November 17-18, 2005.
- Staff was directed by the board to issue a complaint against American Power Electric Corp for alleged unlicensed activity.
- A declaratory statement request submitted by Par Tech, Inc. requesting information regarding whether the company required an electrical license to run cables in fast food businesses to allow the front counter employees to submit customers' food orders to the kitchen was denied. The board indicated that this scope of work did fall within the realm of a limited energy license.
- The board requested that Mark Reddinger attend the November 17-18, 2005 meeting to address the department's unlicensed activity efforts.
- The board voted to hold a telephone conference in October to discuss the draft language regarding electrical system agents. The board has presented the proposed language to its various electrical associations for comment on the language. The associations' comments will be reviewed during the telephone conference.

- The board requested that building officials be contacted to remind them of the requirement for individuals pulling permits for limited energy projects, be licensed by the state to do so.

Action Items

- Present language to Executive Director for the Board of Building Code Administrators and Inspectors advising of requirement for individuals to be licensed to pull permits for limited energy work.
- Issue a complaint against American Power Electric Corp for alleged unlicensed activity.
