Mr. Jones advised that he had questions about the financial statements and information disclosed on the application and within the credit report for Mr. Packard.

MOTION: Ms. Dockery moved to table discussion of the applications until the November 2015 meeting at which time the information about the pending case will be included in the agenda materials.
SECOND: Mr. Buchanan seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

V. DISCUSSIONS

- **Rule 61G7-5.0033, F.A.C. – Consolidated and Combined Financial Statements**

Ms. Clark advised that this rule was being presented due to the Board of Accountancy's repeal of Rule 61H1-20.007, F.A.C. which is referenced in this rule.

Ms. Clark recommended the following language to Rule 61G7-5.0033 (1), F.A.C. for the board's consideration.

All reviewed or audited financial statements submitted to the Department by Florida licensed employee leasing companies shall be presented in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles, as required by s. 468.525(3)(d), F.S.

After review of the recommended the language, the following motion was made.

MOTION: Mr. Finkelstein moved to approve the recommended language to Rule 61G7-5.0033, F.A.C.
SECOND: Ms. Dockery seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

After the motion, Ms. Clark asked if this change would have an adverse impact on small business or be likely to directly or indirectly increase regulatory costs to any entity (including government) in excess of \$200,000 in the aggregate in Florida within 1 year after implementation.

MOTION: Mr. Jones moved that the proposed changes to Rule 61G7-5.0033, F.A.C. would not have an adverse impact on small business or be likely to directly or indirectly increase regulatory costs to any entity (including government) in excess of \$200,000 in the aggregate in Florida within 1 year after implementation.
SECOND: Ms. Dockery seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

The Board determined this change would not require the preparation of a SERC.

- **DBPR EL 4518 – Board Approved Cross Guaranty Form**

Mr. Finkelstein advised that the recommended changes to the cross guarantee form had been made and a draft of the revised form was included in the agenda materials.

Mr. Miller asked if the first and second paragraphs on page two of the packet needed to be changed to state, "of the employee leasing company or group, or any company required to file the cross guarantee form..." being that the guarantor may not be a licensed employee leasing company. He also suggested adding "guarantor" to each of the boxes where it lists the name of the employee leasing company.

Mr. Tack also advised that the rule referenced in the second bullet on page one of the form needed to be corrected to properly reflect the correct rule section of 468.525(3), F.S.

After discussion, the board made the following motion.

MOTION: Mr. Finkelstein moved to approve the cross guarantee form with the recommended changes.

SECOND: Mr. Buchanan seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

Ms. Clark advised that she would move forward with implementing the Board's vote and preparing a response letter to Ms. Holladay addressing the changes.
