Correspondence from American Society of Landscape Architects/National – Change in Course Hours

Ms. Walter advised the board that the American Society of Landscape Architects/National submitted a letter asking for changes to several courses offered at the national meeting in Minneapolis October 6-10, 2006. Ms. Walter stated that the instructor for course number 0008158 Inside the LA Studio, became ill and was not able to deliver the presentation and someone from his office stepped in and delivered the presentation. Ms. Walter advised the board that Rule 61G10-18.006 (8), Florida Administrative Code, states that any change to the name or qualifications of the course instructor or an increase in the number of continuing education credits awarded for the course must be submitted in time to permit review, approval, or denial of the changed course by the board prior to implementation of the proposed change.

Mr. Graham stated that the board may want to think about changing the rule because things happen and illness does occur.

Ms. Guillemette stated that she would put the issue on the rules report. She stated that the board may want to put a provision in the rule for emergencies.

Ms. Chastain asked if Mr. Leighton could submit a rule waiver.
