PORT EVERGLADES PILOTS ASSOCIATION'S MOTION TO INTERVENE

Pursuant to Section 310.151(3), Florida Statutes, and Rule 61G14-22.007(5), Florida Administrative Code, the Port Everglades Pilots Association (the "Association") moves for leave to intervene in this proceeding as an interested party.

1. On July 29, 2014, the Florida-Caribbean Cruise Association (the "FCCA") filed an application for a decrease in the rates of pilotage for vessels that call on Port Everglades.


2. On September 18, 2014, the Board of Pilot Commissioners published notice of the application in the Florida Administrative Register. Consistent with Section 310.151(3), Florida Statutes, and Rule 61G14-22.007(5), Florida Administrative Code, which authorize all "interested parties" to participate in this proceeding, the notice stated that interested parties may file an answer, an additional or alternative application, or any other applicable pleading or response by October 22, 2014.

3. The Association is the association of pilots who perform the pilotage services at Port Everglades. The Association is therefore an interested party statutorily entitled to participate and intends to oppose the FCCA's application and file an alternative application in this proceeding.

4. Counsel for the Association has conferred in good faith with counsel for the FCCA with respect to the relief sought in this motion. The FCCA opposes the motion.

WHEREFORE, the Port Everglades Pilots Association respectfully moves for leave to intervene in this proceeding.


