**I. Major Issues/Actions**

- The board held a telephone conference to approve applications for licensure by examination, endorsement, and continuing education courses. The board reviewed six applications. Three were approved, one continued until the December 2008 meeting and two were denied. The board reviewed 21 applications for continuing education courses from existing providers, all of which were approved.
- The board discussed letters from Florida Surveying and Mapping Society (FSMS) President Pablo Ferrari to its membership, which outlined their desire to move the board from the Department of Business and Professional Regulation to the Department of Agriculture. The board Chair asked all board members to review the letters and educate themselves on the issue, as the board will discuss the issue further and possibly have a vote as to whether they would support the move at their January meeting.
