Mr. Bush introduced Mr. Martin as the new appointed attorney and Mr. Bush also introduced Mr. Greer as new consumer board member.

#### **REVIEW AND APPROVAL OF THE JANUARY 2003 APPLICATION COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES**

The committee reviewed the January 2003 application committee meeting minutes and after review the following motion was made.

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MOTION: Mr. Blankenship made a motion to approve the minutes.  
SECOND: Mr. Cooner seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

### **REVIEW/CONSIDERATION OF APPLICATIONS**

The committee reviewed applications and after review Mr. Bush asked each committee member to report their recommendations of approval or denial.

Mr. Blankenship reported that he reviewed Michael Cook's application for licensure by examination and his recommendation was to deny the application. Mr. Blankenship advised the committee that Mr. Cook had not provided sufficient documentation of work experience.

Mr. Blankenship reported that he reviewed William McLaughlin's application by examination and his recommendation was to approve the application.

Ms. Poppell reported that she reviewed Jeffrey Alan Genzel's application for licensure by endorsement and her recommendation was to deny the application. Ms. Poppell advised the committee that Mr. Genzel had not submitted evidence that he had taken and passed a substantially equivalent licensure examination.

Mr. Bush reported he reviewed two (2) certification of authorization applications. Mr. Bush advised the committee that the Department had recently received Southern Environmental Engineering Company's application and during his review he noted some deficiencies. Mr. Bush's recommendation was to table review of their application to the next meeting to provide time for staff to notify the applicant.

Mr. Bush reported he reviewed Peninsula Surveying & Mapping Companies application. Mr. Bush advised the committee that Mr. Morgan was present at the meeting and he was a representative of the company. Mr. Bush advised Mr. Morgan that during his review he noted an invoice for surveying and mapping services. Mr. Morgan advised the committee that the information was correct. Mr. Bush advised Mr. Morgan that providing surveying and mapping services prior to being issued a certificate of authorization was a violation of Chapter 472, F.S. Mr. Bush recommended that the application be approved with a \$1000.00 penalty. The committee agreed and Mr. Morgan stated he would pay the penalty prior to licensure. Mr. Martin stated he would complete an order.

Mr. Cooner reported he reviewed Angel Bosque's application for licensure by endorsement. Mr. Cooner advised the committee that he recommended denial of the application. Mr. Cooner stated that Mr. Bosque does not meet any avenues of licensure by endorsement. Mr. Cooner stated Mr. Bosque did not provide supporting documentation to be able to determine eligibility. Mr. Cooner stated office staff notified Mr. Bosque of the deficiencies however, Mr. Bosque chose not to provide the information.
