### **III. Considerations of Provider Course Applications**

- Board reviewed 1 provider course application submitted by the Alabama Society of Professional Land Surveyors, course was approved.
- Board reviewed 2 provider course applications submitted by Lorman Business Center Inc. Both courses were denied for not being relevant to the profession.
- Board reviewed 2 provider course applications submitted by the Florida Surveying and Mapping Society. Both courses were approved.
- Board reviewed 4 provider course applications submitted by Allen Nobles & Associates, Inc. All 4 courses were approved.
- Board reviewed 1 provider course application submitted by Professional Development Seminars Inc. The course was denied for not being relevant to the profession.
- Board reviewed 1 provider course application submitted by Florida Chamber's Environmental Network. The course was denied for not being relevant to the profession.
