Mr. Blankenship informed the committee that he has asked the Rules Committee to look at 61G17-5.0051(2), F.A.C., which requires continuing education providers to re-apply for course renewals on the same application as new courses creating a large workload for the providers, staff and board members. Mr. Blankenship also pointed out that there is already a rule in effect that requires any courses with changes to reapply to the board for approval.

Mr. Cooner suggested revising the existing application to make a one page renewal form with a place to fill out if there were no changes in material or instructors.

Mr. Gilmore stated that he renews his providership and courses with no changes on line for other boards with the Department already but when he attempted to renew his for this board the was a hold placed on them.

After discussion the following motion was made:

- MOTION: Mr. Bush made a motion to recommend administratively changing the form and handling of course renewals with no changes at all.
SECOND: Mr. Greer seconded and the motion passed unanimously.
