The committee reviewed the minutes and after discussion, the following motion was made:

REVIEW/CONSIDERATION OF APPLICATIONS

The committee reviewed the following applications and after discussion the following recommendations were made:

Endorsement

Joseph Gary Bowman

Mr. Bowman was not present.

After discussion, it was the consensus of the committee that Mr. Bowman's application did not meet the requirements for licensure by Endorsement.

The committee recommended Mr. Bowman's be denied for failure to provide proof that he held a license to practice surveying and mapping issued prior to July 1, 1999 as required in 472.015(3)(a)1., F.S. Mr. Bowman's application was also denied for failure to show that he held a valid license to practice surveying and mapping issued by another state of the United States that the criteria for issuance of the license was substantially the same as the licensure criteria that existed in Florida at the time the license was issued as required in 472.015 (3)(a)2, F.S. The committee also recommended contingent approval for the application for licensure by Examination if he requests to convert the application from licensure by Endorsement to licensure by Examination within 30 days. Mr. Bowman's NCEES scores were accepted.

Beth Ann Braun

Ms. Braun was not present.

After discussion, it was the consensus of the committee that Ms. Braun's application for licensure by Endorsement did not meet the requirements due to failure to provide proof that she held a valid license to practice surveying and mapping issued by another state of the United States that the criteria for issuance of the license was substantially the same as the licensure criteria that existed in Florida at the time the license was issued.

The committee recommended Ms. Braun's application for licensure by Endorsement be denied due to failure to provide proof that she held a valid license to practice surveying and mapping issued by another state of the United States that the criteria for issuance of the license was substantially the same as the licensure criteria that existed in Florida at the time the license was issued as required in 472.015 (3)(a)2, F.S.

111 The committee recommended Ms. Conley's application for licensure by Endorsement be
112 withdrawn and considered by Examination and to allow her to waive the 90 day deemer
113 requirement to allow the application to be continued to verify 3 more months of
114 responsible charge experience.

116 **Robby Lee Litherland**

118 Mr. Litherland was present.

120 After discussion, it was the consensus of the committee that Mr. Litherland would not
121 meet the requirements for licensure by Endorsement because he did not hold a license
122 to practice surveying and mapping issued prior to July 1, 1999 as required in
123 472.015(3)(a)1., F.S.

125 The committee recommended Mr. Litherland's application for licensure by Endorsement
126 be denied for failure to show that he holds a license to practice surveying and mapping
127 issued prior to July 1, 1999 as required in 472.015(3)(a)1., F.S. Mr. Litherland's
128 application was also denied for failure to show proof that he held a valid license to
129 practice surveying and mapping issued by another state of the United States that the
130 criteria for issuance of the license was substantially the same as the licensure criteria
131 that existed in Florida at the time the license was issued as required in 472.015 (3)(a)2,
132 F.S.

162 Mr. Robbins was present.

164 After discussion, it was the consensus of the committee that Mr. Robbins' application for
165 licensure by examination only provided proof of 54 months in responsible charge and 6
166 more months in responsible charge would need to be provided. Mr. Robbins waived his
167 90 day deemer requirement.

169 The committee recommended Mr. Robbins' application for licensure by examination be
170 continued to the July 2008 board meeting to allow him time to provide 6 more months of
171 verified experience in responsible charge.

173 **Walter Volkmann**

175 Mr. Volkmann was present.

176

177 After discussion, it was the consensus of the committee that Mr. Volkmann's application
178 for licensure by examination only provided 43.5 months of experience in responsible
179 charge and 16.5 more months in responsible charge would need to be provided. Mr.
180 Volkmann waived his 90 day deemer requirement.

181

182 The committee recommended Mr. Volkmann's application for licensure by examination
183 be continued to the July 2008 board meeting to allow him time to provide 16.5 more
184 months of verified experience in responsible charge.

186 **Zhi W. Yang**

188 Mr. Yang was not present.

189

190 After discussion, it was the consensus of the committee that Mr. Yang's application for
191 licensure by Examination did not meet the requirements.

193 The committee recommended Mr. Yang's application for licensure by Examination be
194 denied due to failure to provide proof of 48 months of verified experience in responsible
195 charge as required in 472.013(2)(a), F.S.

197 **Surveyor In Training**

199 **Kelly Garner**

201 Mr. Garner was present.

202

203 After discussion, it was the consensus of the committee that Mr. Garner would need to
204 provide a copy of transcripts showing that he graduated in May 2007. Mr. Garner
205 waived his 90 day deemer requirement.

207 The committee recommended Mr. Garner's application as a Surveyor in Training be
208 continued to the July 2008 board meeting to allow him to provide proof that he graduated
209 with a degree in surveying and mapping as required in 472.013(3), F.S.

211 **Lisa Michelle Nesi**

212

213 Ms. Nesi was present.

214

215 After discussion, it was the consensus of the committee that Ms. Nesi did not have a
216 degree in surveying and mapping. Ms. Nesi's degree was in Geology.

217

218 The committee recommended Ms. Nesi be allowed to withdraw her application as a
219 surveyor in training due to failure to provide proof that she had a degree in surveying
220 and mapping as required in 472.013(3), F.S.

222 **Land Surveyor Business**

224 **BBLs Surveyors & Mappers, Inc.**

228 **JMM Surveying and Mapping, LLC.**

230 After discussion, the committee recommended this business application be approved
231 contingent upon payment of an assessment of \$1,000 for operating without a Certificate
232 of Authorization.
