681 language.

682

683 **61G18-16.003 Continuing Education Standards.**

684 (1) The continuing education requirements outlined in Rules 61G18-16.001 and 61G18-16.002,
685 F.A.C., may be complied with by attendance at approved scientific veterinary medical meetings. A
686 licensed veterinarian shall receive credit for no more than five (5) hours of continuing professional
687 education in business, practice management courses or stress and impairment seminars during any
688 biennium period.

689

690

691 61G18-16.002 Continuing Education Requirements for Active Status License Renewal.

692 (1) No change.

693

694 (2) Licensed veterinarians shall complete a minimum of thirty (30) hours of continuing
695 professional education in veterinary medicine every biennium. Beginning on June 1, 2012, no
696 less than one (1) hour of continuing education shall be in the area of dispensing legend drugs
697 and no less than two (2) hours of continuing education shall be in the area of the laws and rules
governing the practice of veterinary medicine. For the purposes of this rule, the laws and rules

698 governing the practice of veterinary medicine are Chapters 455 and 474, F.S. and Rule Title
699 61G18, F.A.C.

700 (a) through (d) No change.

701 (e) A licensed veterinarian shall receive credit for no more than five (5) hours of continuing
702 professional education in business or practice management courses during any biennium
703 period.

704 (f) A licensed veterinarian shall receive credit for no more than five (5) hours of continuing
705 professional education in wellness and wellbeing seminars during any biennium period.

706 (3) through (6) No change.

707
