Only original edition reference materials will be allowed for use at the examination, except for the references specifically indicated on the reference list as a PDF.

Reference materials **MUST** be bound and remain bound during the exam. Bound refers to materials permanently bound, as by stitching or glue, and materials securely fastened in their covers by fasteners that penetrate all papers. PDF copies of references **MUST** be bound with ring binders, brads, plastic snap binders, spiralbound notebooks, and screw posts, but not with staples. Writing tablets or electronic tablets are not allowed.

References containing underlining with pen or highlighter may be used. Hand-written and typewritten notes are <u>NOT</u> allowed. Existing hand-written notes must be blackened out or removed completely, by the candidate, prohibiting legibility. Moveable tabs (e.g., Post-it[®] Flags) are <u>NOT</u> allowed. You will not be permitted to make any marks in your references during the examination.
