

ASBESTOS PROVIDER AND COURSE RENEWAL INFORMATION

Pursuant to Section 455.2179(1), Florida Statutes, all provider and course approvals will expire on May 31 of odd numbered years.

It is asked of all providers who wish to continue offering basic and refresher training courses in Florida to submit renewal application for re-evaluation of the course(s). All courses not renewed by May 31 will be placed in a null and void status. Please review your current list of courses and submit applications for those courses that you wish to renew. The course renewal fee is \$100 per course, and provider renewal fee is \$100. Providers please follow the option below when preparing course renewal applications.

1. Submit the renewal application and the entire course material for re-evaluation for compliance with the relevant state and federal laws. Please include all information referenced under “Supporting Documents” on page 1 of the application. Also include the letter received from the department with a list of DBPR approved instructors and their current certificates for the courses they are approved to teach. If you have new instructors, please include their resumes and certificates for the courses you would like for them to teach.

If during the review and evaluation of your application, it is determined that additional information is required, the Bureau will contact you to request such information. All asbestos courses, as listed in Rule 61E1-2.006, Florida Administrative Code, must be approved by the DBPR in order for attendees to receive credits. You must submit a separate application for each course.

The course application is available on the department’s website at www.MyFlorida.com/dbpr. You must submit a separate application for each course along with all supporting documents. You are hereby advised to submit your applications as early as possible since the review process could take 30 or more days to complete. You must have already received your provider renewal notice in the mail. You can renew your provider status on-line; however, course renewal applications must be submitted to the department.
