

## **FLORIDA FARM LABOR CONTRACTOR'S EXAMINATION PROCESS**

The Department of Business and Professional Regulation offers the Florida Farm Labor Contractor's written (English and Spanish) examination as a computer based test at various locations throughout the state. The examination is offered Monday through Saturday.

To take the computer based examination, applicants must first apply to the department and be approved to take the examination. The application and examination fee of \$160 must be submitted with the application. The payment must be in the form of a certified check or money order made payable to the Department of Business and Professional Regulation. The examination is offered by PearsonVue, the department's testing vendor. Upon receiving the approval notification, applicants seeking to take the written examination in English or Spanish can schedule on-line at [www.pearsonvue.com](http://www.pearsonvue.com) or by calling toll free at 1.866.936.7782. You will receive an appointment letter from PearsonVue confirming the examination date, time and location. Please make sure you have two forms of identification when you arrive at the testing site to take the examination. You will be given 90 minutes to complete the examination. You do not need any computer experience to take this examination. A step by step tutorial will walk you through the test taking process.

Once you have completed and passed the examination, Pearson Vue will provide you with a grade report which will include your picture and passing status. If your federal registration is current and you have passed the examination, the department will mail the license to the address provided on your application.

Applicants who fail the examination must re-apply to the department and pay a fee of \$35. You can schedule through Pearson Vue again to take the examination.

The department will offer the oral examinations at the Immokalee, Brandon, Orlando and Tallahassee sites. The Haitian/Creole examination will be offered at the Immokalee and Fort Pierce sites. Please call the department directly at 850-487-9714, if you wish to schedule for the oral or Creole examination.

The Pearson Vue test center staff is not authorized to help you complete the application. You are responsible for completing and submitting the application to the department prior to taking the examination
